Corgill Happy Heart Ranch (CHHR) has AQHA Champion Stallion Face It Im Good, registration # 3278932, available for breeding to AQHA, APHA and TB mares. The breeding season contract period in force for this contract shall begin Feb 1, 2009 and end July 1, 2009. Stallion collection, in-house mare artificial insemination, and cooled semen shipment will be handled by Kendall County Equine Clinic (KCEC).

- A-** To make this contract valid CHHR must be in possession of:
- 1- a signed original contract
 - 2- photocopy of mare's breed association registration papers showing current owner
 - 3- for TBs a copy of TB's AQHA listing number
 - 4- payment of the non-refundable booking fee on signing of contract
 - 5- payment balance of the Stud fee and any other outstanding fees prior to shipment

B- The Stud fee for 2009 is \$950. The non-refundable booking fee is \$300 and is credited to the Stud fee. The contract Stud fee/booking fee is a one-time payment to CHHR either by check payable to Corgill Happy Heart Ranch or bank to bank wire transfer. **Embryo Transfers:** Each embryo transferred to a recipient mare must pay the Stud fee per contract. Each settled recipient mare is allowed live foal guarantee. **Multiple mare discount:** If two (2) mares are bred, multiple owners allowed, the first will pay the full Stud fee including the booking fee, the second will be **free**. Multiple embryo transfers qualify for this discount.

C- Stallion will be available for collection on **Mon, Wed and Fri**. A **24-hour notice must be given** by mare owner to KCEC (830-336-2041) or CHHR (210-373-3880) when requesting semen. Mare owner must confirm or cancel this request with KCEC or CHHR by **10:00 AM Central Time** on the requested day of collection. While every attempt will be made to ship two doses, only one dose is guaranteed to be shipped. Shipment of cooled semen is made in a Shipping Container which requires a deposit. Mare owner may purchase from KCEC a disposable container for shipment and must make this request when ordering the collection/shipment of semen.

D- Normal Priority Overnight FedEx shipment is available Mon, Wed, and Fri for delivery the next day. Some destinations do not have Sat delivery and may require mare owner to pick up the shipment at their local FedEx office. Mare owner will be given the FedEx tracking number. Mare owner should contact FedEx at 800-463-3339 with this number for any questions about the delivery. If delivery is required on the same day as collection, counter to counter air shipment can be arranged for destinations served by Southwest, American, and Delta. Mare owner will be advised by KCEC of the shipping cost for this type of service including courier's fees to the airport.

E- KCEC must receive collection/shipping contact information, to include names, addresses and phone numbers. Prior to any shipment for this contract, all collection/shipping fees and deposits must be paid. Collection/shipping fees and deposits are due KCEC either by a check payable to Kendall County Equine Clinic or by credit card. These fees will be charged for each collection and shipment made in the contract period.

The collection fee is \$250.

Shipping fee for FedEx next day service is \$100 (\$150 for Canada). There will be an additional \$25 fee for Sat delivery. These fees are subject to rate increases by FedEx.

Counter to counter shipping fee will be by quote.

The refundable deposit for the Shipping Container is \$250. The Shipping Container must be returned at mare owner's expense and arrive at KCEC **within five days** of the original shipped date, at which time the deposit will be refunded. For each day beyond the five days from the original date of shipment the return is not completed, mare owner will be charged \$25, deductible from the deposit. If the mare owner requests to purchase a disposable equitainer at a cost of \$45, the deposit and requirement to return the container do not apply.

F- The responsibility for conception is on the mare owner. Mare owner represents that the mare is in sound breeding condition, free from any infection or disease. Mare owner agrees to comply with AQHA or other pertaining breed requirements concerning the use and handling of cooled semen. Mare owner agrees to perform the insemination within 24 hours but not more that 48 hours from receipt.

G- If the mare is to be bred on site at KCEC, mare owner agrees to make all arrangements with and pay to KCEC any and all fees incurred by their mare, including but not limited to board, examinations, sonograms, drugs, and procedures necessary to insure proper timing of insemination.

H- This contract is Live Foal Guarantee once the mare has been certified to have settled. "Live Foal" means being able to stand on its own and nurse. CHHR upon notification of a Live Foal will issue to the mare owner the Breeders Certificate for the foal conceived by this mating provided that all fees and bills to CHHR and KCEC are paid in full.

I- The breeding contract period for this contract may be extended to the 2010 breeding season, with **payment of a \$300 rebreed fee for each mare**, for the following reasons:

- 1-If the mare aborts her foal, or does not deliver a live foal.
- 2-If the mare proves barren, with an approved substitute mare.
- 3-If the mare dies before producing a live foal, with an approved substitute mare.
- 4-If the mare becomes unfit to breed before becoming safe in foal, with an approved substitute mare.

The collection/shipping fees, deposits, and any mare care fees must be paid to KCEC for each collection. These fees will be at the 2010 posted rates. No previously paid Stud/booking fee, collection/shipping fee, or mare care fee will be refunded. Stallion owner will have no further liability hereunder for servicing said mare or approved substitute mare beyond the 2010 breeding season.
